

#### BY ROAD:

#### **NÉRIS-LES-BAINS**

From the north (Paris, Orléans): A71 motorway, exit 10 Bizeneuille, then take the direction Commentry. From the south (Clermont-Ferrand): A71 motorway, exit 11.

From the east (Mâcon, Moulins): A79 motorway, exit 34, take the direction Montmarault, then Commentry.

From the west (Guéret via RN 145): take the direction Montluçon, then Clermont-Ferrand via RD 2144.

From the south (Clermont-Ferrand): A71 motorway, exit 11.

Montluçon SNCF station – 8 km from Néris and 30 km from Montmarault.





## nature & escape

Here, everything invites you to slow down and (finally) take your time. Take the time to walk, to breathe, to observe. Take the time to give yourself time to feel good, to treat yourself: put simply, time for yourself.

Here are some of our favourite green walks and the very best spots for a siesta in the sun, soaking up plenty of vitamin D.

### Our 5 national forests it's good for the soul!

Discover true peace and the beauty of nature during a relaxed walk in the forest. Let yourself be enchanted by the majestic trees and soft rustling of the leaves. Discover the diversity of flora and fauna, listen to the birdsong and breathe in the fresh air. Whether it's alone, with family or with friends, a forest work is a soothing break from the everyday and the chance to discover nature in its purest state. Recharge your batteries.

Their names: La Suave, Lespinasse, Dreuille, Château-Charles and Vacheresse.

A few basic rules before setting off into the forest:

- #1 check the forecast
- #2 take good shoes and suitable clothing
- #3 bring water and a snack
- #4 take a map, you won't get mobile signal everywhere
- #5 respect protected areas, plots under regeneration, forestry sites and hunting zones by not entering them

















### The Voie Verte pedestrian way perfect for everyone!

This former railway line linking Néris-les-Bains to Montluçon has been redeveloped into a pedestrian and cycle path. With a gentle gradient throughout, it's ideal for walking in all seasons. It crosses three viaducts, built between 1921 and 1929, and stretches out over the Néris countryside for 6.4 km.

Tip: why not go for a walk at the end of the day to admire the beautiful sunsets?

#### An endless horizon

Head to the «Rue de la Croix de Pierre» in Venas to take advantage of a beautiful panoramic view over the wooded landscape. There, you'll be able to admire the «bouchures»\* that line the fields, the many patches of woodland and the spires of the various church bell towers in the area. A Christianised menhir stands at the crossroads of ancient roads

### Our lakes calm and serenity

A little walk around a lake to enjoy the harmonious combination of water and nature. Let yourself be enchanted by the sky's reflection on the clear water. Walk around the lake at your own pace and enjoy a picnic, serenaded by the sound of lapping water.

#### The Tree Trail

In the Belle Époque, the spa town of Néris-les-Bains decided to take the gamble to stand out and grow its wealth. Several rare trees were therefore imported from Asia and America.

In the inviting shade of our six parks, you'll recognise a few familiar species while you discover other, much rarer specimens. A walk in the heart of nature, travelling to the world's end through trees. Ask for the Tree Trail leaflet at the Néris-les-Bains Tourist Office.

#### «Le sentier du Tacot»

★ 5.5 km, 1.5 hoursDifficulty: Very easyStarting point: Town hall car park

With family, come and take on part of the old Tacot's 19th-century route. The Tacot was the train that ran on the secondary railway network.

St-Bonnet-de-Four houses a bell tower unique in Auvergne, as its spire twists to the left. Proud of this unique characteristic, the town forms part of the Twisted Bell Towers of Europe Association.



#### «La ronde angéloise»

Come and enjoy a loop around the Saint-Angélois area, as you discover its many crosses and landscapes.

This hike, crossing a variety of landscapes, offers a panoramic view of the Bourbonnais wooded countryside, extending as far as Combrailles. Make a stop at the Saint-Michel church, whose bell tower houses one of the oldest bells in the Bourbonnais



# Cycle route «Montmarault par monts et par vaux»

52 km Difficulty: Intermediate Starting point: Montmarault

This beautiful route crosses the Bourbonnais countryside from village to village. After Saint-Bonnet-de-Four and its church with twisted bell tower (see page 10), a very leisurely section follows. Then, from Villefrance-d'Allier, charming little roads – often lined with hedges – lead you to the valleys of the Bourbonnais wooded countryside. A fantastic walk in the country!



Our GR© long-distance hiking routes

Our towns are crossed by two GR© hiking routes: the GR© 342 (Néris-les-Bains, Durdat-Larequille and La Celle) and the GR© 303 (Néris-les-Bains).

### The Via Sancti Martini the European cultural route

Echoing the Way of St James, this route links the East and West of Europe. From the birthplace of Saint Martin in Tours, across Hungry, Slovenia, Italy and France, this route passes through Néris-les-Bains, Commentry, Colombier, Hyds, Louroux-de-Beaune, Beaune-d'Allier, Blomard and Vernusse.



#### **The Bell-Tower Route**

On foot or by bike, follow the bell towers of the Sainte-Famille parish thanks to 28 signposted routes.

As well as churches and bell towers, a host of other riches and curiosities await: the Saint Patrocle fountain in Colombier, the Cornassat cross in Beaune-d'Allier, the former Nérisles-Bains train station or even the Verneix cannon ... Stop to admire these finds along your way, you might be surprised by the stories they have to tell.

St-Bonnet-de-Four

### The only twisted bell tower in Auvergne

If you have a keen eye, you're sure to spot this unique feature from a distance on the road that leads you to the village of Saint-Bonnet-de-Four, no matter which route you take!

The only twisted bell tower in the Bourbonnais, and even in Auvergne, that of the Saint-Bonnet church bell tower is particularly coiled and has been since the late 19th century: the clock tower was burnt down by thunder in 1894 and rebuilt with wood that was so green that it twisted.

#### The André Messager theatre

Let yourself be carried away by the opulent architecture, the ornate decorations and the intimate atmosphere of the Néris-les-Bains theatre.

Amid a historic setting, this Italian-style theatre will transport you to another time. Together, its red-velvet seats, dancing allegories and dome make up the incredible charm of this little architectural gem. Guided tours according to the programme of events.

Today known as the «André Messager theatre», it owes its name to the famous French composer and conductor born in Montluçon.




#### Colombier

#### The Saint Patrocle fountain

Legend has it that, with no water to build his church and monastery, Saint Patrocle launched a hammer into the air as he uttered the following words: «Where my hammer falls, a spring shall gush forth». Falling around a hundred metres from the church, water miraculously sprung from the earth, giving birth to the Saint Patrocle Fountain.

Across two different routes (13.3 km or 14.8 km), the Fountains Circuit invites you to discover seven of these water features. Find the route at the Néris-les-Bains Tourist Office, at the Montmarault Tourist Centre or by consulting the town's website at www.colombier03.fr





#### **The Font Gargot**

As you make your way around the Dreuille Forest, leave the main path behind and adventure into the woods to discover the Font Gargot (arrows indicate its location).

The Font Gargot once supplied the washhouse used by the inhabitants of neighbouring villages, as well as the ancient La Madeleine Priory lake, now disappeared. Nearby, take advantage of a few peaceful moments to soak up the greenery or immersive yourself in all the flamboyant colours of autumn.

#### **Granite chaos**

Bearing witness to the erosion of rocks over millions of years, their clustering in fields is often the mark of human action on the landscape.


Characteristic of Louroux-de-Beaune and the surrounding towns, they provide food and shelter to many plant and animal species.

To be discovered along the walking loop: «The Grey Rocks Trail» (9 km, difficulty: easy)

#### The Creux Chaud

Underground source of crystalclear water which never freezes. The Creux Chaud (or «hot hollow») is located at the foot of the ruins of the Château du Murat (now private). An impressive building constructed in the 11th and 13th centuries, the castle was once the residence of the Lords of Bourbon until it was dismantled in 1531 following the death of the Constable of France.

This spring inspired the author Jean-Charles Varennes (1915– 1995) to write «Les fiancés du Creux Chaud».





#### The Cascade

A dyke had been built here to create a reservoir used to wash coal on the Ris Voirat. Over time, the effects of erosion created a breach, resulting in this beautiful waterfall.

Head to Les Bourdignats. You'll pass in front of the former mine administration buildings, now abandoned, before continuing to make your way along the Voirat stream in a calm and leafy environment. After a short climb, take the path to your right and follow it to the water intake.

#### **German sentry boxes**


In the middle of a hiking route around the town of Néris-les-Bains, you will spot four German sentry boxes taken from Nantes. These sentry boxes were recovered in the 50s and 60s to protect quarrymen from fire and explosions.

The thermal water of Néris-les-Bains draws its unique composition from the rocks it passes on its long underground journey before finally emerging from its source. Its high content of lithium and magnesium offer it sedative, analgesic, balancing and relaxing properties, recognised by the French Academy of Medicine. It is thanks to these properties that the resort is prescribed for stress, depressive states, nerve disorders and even osteoarthritis and rheumatism.

# history & heritage

#### **Escape to Gallo-Roman lands**

Since time immemorial, our land has been a crossroads for travel and exchanges, crossed by Roman roads. Various excavations have made it possible to rediscover the remains: this heritage is particularly clear to see in Néris-les-Bains, where inhabitants have long enjoyed the virtues of thermal water in several establishments.

#### The Gallo-Roman Museum

Rediscover the story of Aquae Nerii by visiting the museum dedicated to Gallo-Roman remains, discovered from the 19th century onwards. As the only Gallo-Roman museum in Allier, the Néris-les-Bains museum invites you to discover Gallo-Roman civilisation. Ceramics, representations of divinities, columns, frescoes or everyday objects will allow you to imagine the public and domestic lives of the town's inhabitants in ancient times. The museum is open from Wednesday to Saturday, 14:30 to 18:00 (May to October) for self-guided visits. Piqued your interest? Guided tours are organised on certain Fridays (request the programme of events from the Néris-les-Bains Tourist Office or the Montmarault Tourist Centre).




#### The Gallo-Roman theatre-amphitheatre

Also known as the «Parc des Arènes», this semi-circular building was once home to both a stage and an arena, surrounded by stands, in which theatrical performances and circus games were presented. The semicircle of the theatre-amphitheatre, as well as a few small-stone walls, are still visible today.

Did you know? This ancient Roman theatre-amphitheatre could welcome up to 3,000 people. It was listed as a historic monument in 1862.







Set off and discover historic, architectural, geographic and human heritage with the help of 24 enamelled-lava panels. This route will tell you all about the history of the village, located on the borders of Auvergne and the Bourbonnais, whose remains date all the way back to prehistoric times.

The village's patron saint, Saint Aignan, will share all the legends surrounding these sites with you. He will guide you to the sites of existing or former castles. Just around a «bouchure»\*, you'll be able to admire stunning views as you discover a place deeply marked by history.

\* local name for a hedge characteristic of the wooded countryside

Various hiking routes (from 4 to 15 km) are available from the Néris-les-Bains Tourist Office, at the Montmarault Tourist Centre or from the town hall.





#### The Bourbons

The former name of the Allier province, the Bourbonnais, recalls its origins - closely entwined with the history of France, particularly in the Middles Ages. From the 10th century onwards, the first Lords of Bourbon gradually fortified and expanded their land. In the 14th century. Duke Louis II inherited the Duchy of the Bourbonnais, the County of Clermont en Beauvaisis and the County of La Marche, later extending his property with Le Forez, the Barony of Combraille, the castellanies of Nièvre, the Barony of Beaujolais and the Principality of Dombes. The Bourbons, loyal to the Kingdom of France, had many vassals and our landscapes and villages have been marked by them in their urban planning, their remains and, sometimes in their names. For example, we can admire the ruins of the Murat fortress (private), once known as the «Le Riche» Murat castellany, and keen eyes will be able to make out the rounded streets, characteristic of ancient ditches or fortifications. as seen in Malicorne or Cosne-d'Allier around the church. Meanwhile, the medieval churches of Néris-les-Bains, Chamblet, Chappes, Chavenon or Sauvagny (private church) date back, at least in large part, to the Roman period and are welldeserving of a visit.

#### Here too, we were miners!

The intensive coal-mining of the 19th century has visibly modified the landscapes and life of the western part of our land. The veins were mined from various pits, boosting populations and extending villages.

Bézenet, for example, a simple hamlet of just a few houses, gradually became a town in its own right, independent of Montvicq, with nearly 5,000 inhabitants.

Commentry was transformed from a village to a small industrial town thanks to mining, followed by blacksmithing. Even today, it remains highly industrialised.


Though the pits were destroyed upon the closure of the mines in Commentry, Doyet, Bézenet, Montvicq and Deneuille-les-Mines, the landscapes and place names still bear witness to this history.

As you cross the towns and villages, think of the thousands of workers who once populated these ancient mining districts. Imagine the smell of coal and the wagons that transported it to Montlucon.





The Heritage Route: Thanks to seven information panels dotted throughout the town, Commentry offers visitors the chance to discover the rich history of this blacksmiths' town. Find the route at the Néris-les-Bains Tourist Office, the Montmarault Tourist Centre or in the town of Commentry.



### The Belle-Époque the start of tourism

Néris-les-Bains was an elegant and festive thermal resort. The presence of a bourgeois and aristocratic clientele following the construction of a thermal establishment in 1826 was confirmed during the Belle Époque and the spa tourism that gripped socialites breathed new life into the resort. As such, various hotels and villas were developed, along with parks and the beautiful theatre and casino complex in 1897.

Another symbol of the importance of spa tourism: the Néris-les-Bains train station, now known as the Pavillon du Lac. This art-deco building (constructed between 1929 and 1931) impressed all those who laid eyes on it with its great, sandstone elevation, its glazed roofs with geometric motifs and its size (for a small town of around 3,500 inhabitants at the time). It operated between 1931 and 1972.


